Be part of a competitive, yet fun weekend with a chance to race and socialise with competitors from other yacht clubs.

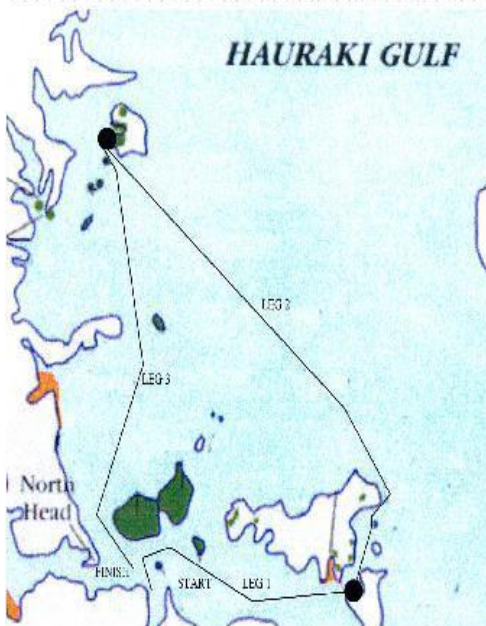
Overall prizes will be awarded in divisions of general handicap and one combined scoring of PHRF.
