## **Winter Series #1 Race Account**

Finally - after 9 weeks (or so) of lockdown and no sailing we had the start of the winter series, with 5 boats on the start line - Sir Duke, Flaming Lips, Rajah, Tart & Buoy Racer. Strong Persuader was still stuck on the quickhaul with apparent issues on the engine and Babe had the 88 2handed Nationals to attend. With these 2 boats for the next race we should have the usual 7+ boats on the start line.

Sir Duke was off on scratch in the absence of MacHeath, 16 minutes ahead of us in a 2 lap race. Great weather in breezy sou'westerly conditions - a wee bit cold for starters, but everyone warmed up quickly, shaking out the cobwebs. These were on pretty much all boats, but Sir Duke by the looks of things. A good start and no one was to catch the Farr727 again today.

There were issues a plenty - Flaming Lips: issues with the kite, failure of primary winches & stuck on the mud for a couple of minutes; Tart - now this would have been a great photo off the start line, displaying an upside down kite hoist (no names will be named here ...) & a touch of mud I heard; Rajah - a touch of mud; Buoy Racer - well, having a nice time with the kite up on the first run until we couldn't make the first red mark - should have taken the height while we had the chance ... so we took the short route; dropped the kite & went back to take the mark on our starboard side - not the port side. This would have cost us a few precious minutes to catch up the fleet. So we treated the first lap as a trial run in sunny conditions. The second lap was our redemption lap. No boats except us put kites up (to give us a chance to catch up we guessed). We finally hit double digits on the downwind run. Upwind we tried our best to catch at least one yacht, and Flaming Lips's mishaps - aka getting stuck on the mud on the final stretch - did help the cause.

The final rankings - Sir Duke, Rajah, Tart, Buoy Racer & Flaming Lips.

Great to be back on the river to shake off the cobwebs and having a quiet one in our club rooms after. See you all back in two weeks. (Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2020)
